NALC Disaster Relief (from Mary Bates)

NALC Disaster Response continues to provide emergency relief supplies and provide volunteers to help reach the very rural communities that other organizations are not serving. We have now used approximately 40 teams of 4 wheelers and side by sides (from NC & SC) to deliver to the areas without accessible roads. A big thank you to St. Paul Pomaria and Paul Werts with Celebrate Freedom Foundation and Jerry Miller at Organ Lutheran Church and all their 4wheelers. We continue to assist the large donation centers by providing volunteers and pick-up trucks / 4wheel drive vehicles to redistribute the amazing donations that have been received. A total of 16 communities have now been served by NALC Disaster Response with 26' box trucks and emergency relief supplies from every warehouse east of the Mississippi River and we will continue to serve as needs are identified. Hundreds of our NALC volunteers have donated their time and energy to serve as the hands and feet of Jesus.

I am compiling a list of our resources which have been used to date and dollar value in addition to the hundreds of volunteer hours donated.

Volunteers have started providing "muck & gut", first locations are in Creston at the community center and Clyde and now Bakersvi!le. Additionally, NALC Disaster Response is coordinating needs and lists of priority needs from our sister congregations throughout NALC - thank you Jesus! As questions arise, I am ready with answers – please call or text me at 740-509-1132. What is greatest need? Camp showers (portable, individual) and garden hoses and then health kits, so they have soap and shampoo to shower.

If someone wants to make a monetary donation, then it should be sent to: NALC Disaster Response, 2113 Harwood Rd., Suite 309, PMB 409, Bedford, Texas 76021-4703. Memo line should say Hurricane Helene. Additionally, we have done a tremendous job collecting camping gear and thank you everyone and Pastor Steven King for the donations from Scouting Inc. Therefore, the needs are for gifts cards which include ability to purchase propane (which becoming more available daily), gift cards to purchase gasoline (gas stations are coming online), rakes & shovels (all types), and garden hoses, individual camp showers (portable) - our

shower trailers cannot be transported into the rural areas that need them and they will be deployed more centrally. We continue to have the need for volunteers to help work the donation centers and also make deliveries.
